In an effort to fulfill our most pressing goals, we have established phasing for each of our three annual budgets, identifying the costs associated with operations and activities between January and July, and through the end of each year.

We must raise these amounts to fund our primary activities in 2010:

Capacity Building ~ To build a demo and prototype for Access Health Library & Access Health Forums, in collaboration with the Concept Web Alliance;	\$25,000	\$150,000
Events ~ To support our 1 st international symposium on May 19, in Geneva, Switzerland, which is free to all registered participants	\$15,000 (through May)
